

Title: ICT Activities Wallchart

Cybercitizenship Attribute: Connected

Level: Year 0-2

Overview: In this activity students brainstorm a range of activities they carry out using ICT. Using retail catalogues (junk mail) they cut and paste images of various technologies that can be used for these activities onto posters that are labelled with the suggested activities.

Connect	<p>Explain to the class that you are going to make some posters about ICT and what we use it for.</p> <p>Introduce the class to the concept of ICT. (This is a broad concept but ICT does have things in common such as use of electricity (or batteries), used to communicate with people, or used to ‘consume’ media (videos, music etc).</p>	<p>Resources</p> <p>A range of technology retail catalogues (for cutting images from and pasting onto wall chart)</p> <p>Large paper (A2 or A1)</p> <p>Scissors (class set)</p> <p>Glue</p>
Activate	<p>Brainstorm with students the various ICT they have in class and at school. Then brainstorm all of the things they or someone else might use these for.</p> <p>Add to this with ICT they or someone else has at home, and the types of things they do with the devices.</p>	<p>Assessment</p> <p>Monitor children as they paste onto the posters to check their understanding. Many devices could fit into more than one category. Ask children to justify their selections.</p>
Demonstrate	<p>Choose some of the more common <i>activities</i> that were suggested and label the large sheets of paper with one activity each.</p> <p>Ask the children to cut pictures of ICT devices from the catalogues and paste them onto the sheets depending on whether they think the device can be used to perform the activity.</p> <p>The posters could be left on an activity table with the catalogues for a few days. Children could bring other catalogues or images from home to add to the posters and paste them on in their own time.</p>	
Consolidate	<p>When complete, discuss the posters looking at the range of activities and technologies. Some of the items may appear on more than one poster e.g. a mobile phone can be used for communicating, gaming or browsing the web.</p> <p>Display the posters along with explanations and other questions e.g.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• “We use these things to talk to people far away”• “Can you think of anything else that could be in here?”
